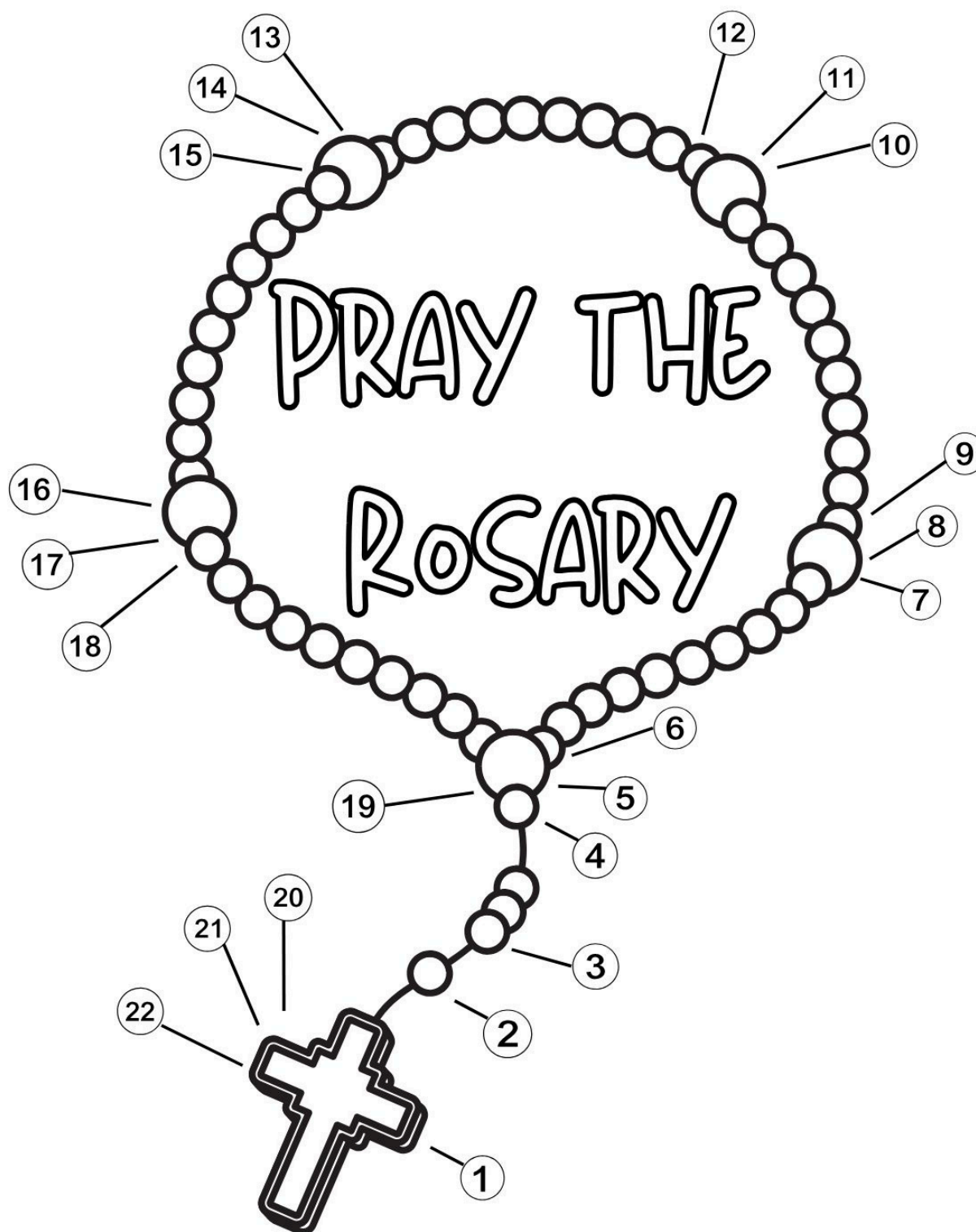

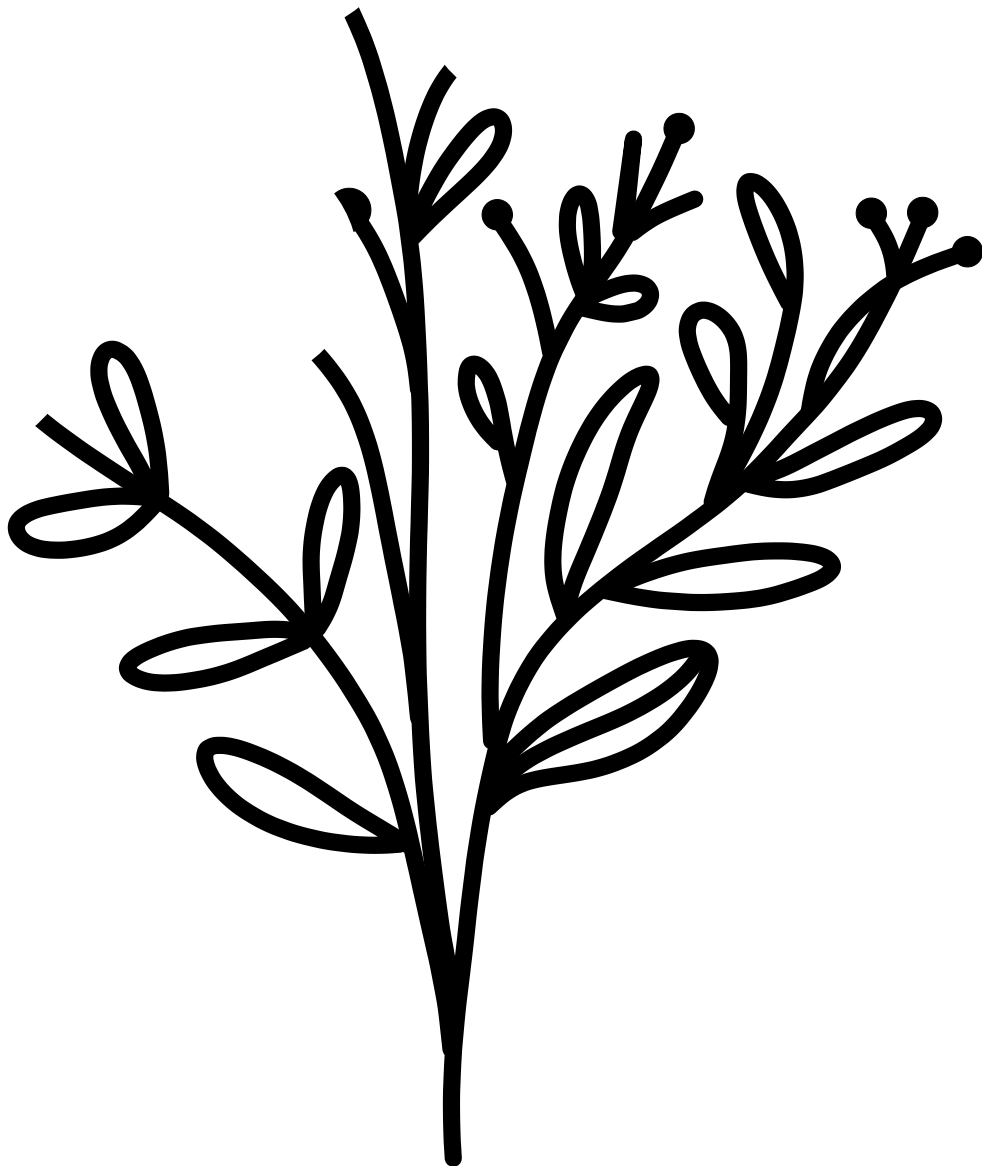

**The Finding of Jesus in the Temple:** 12 year old Jesus went missing for three days, and His parents found Him safe in the temple.

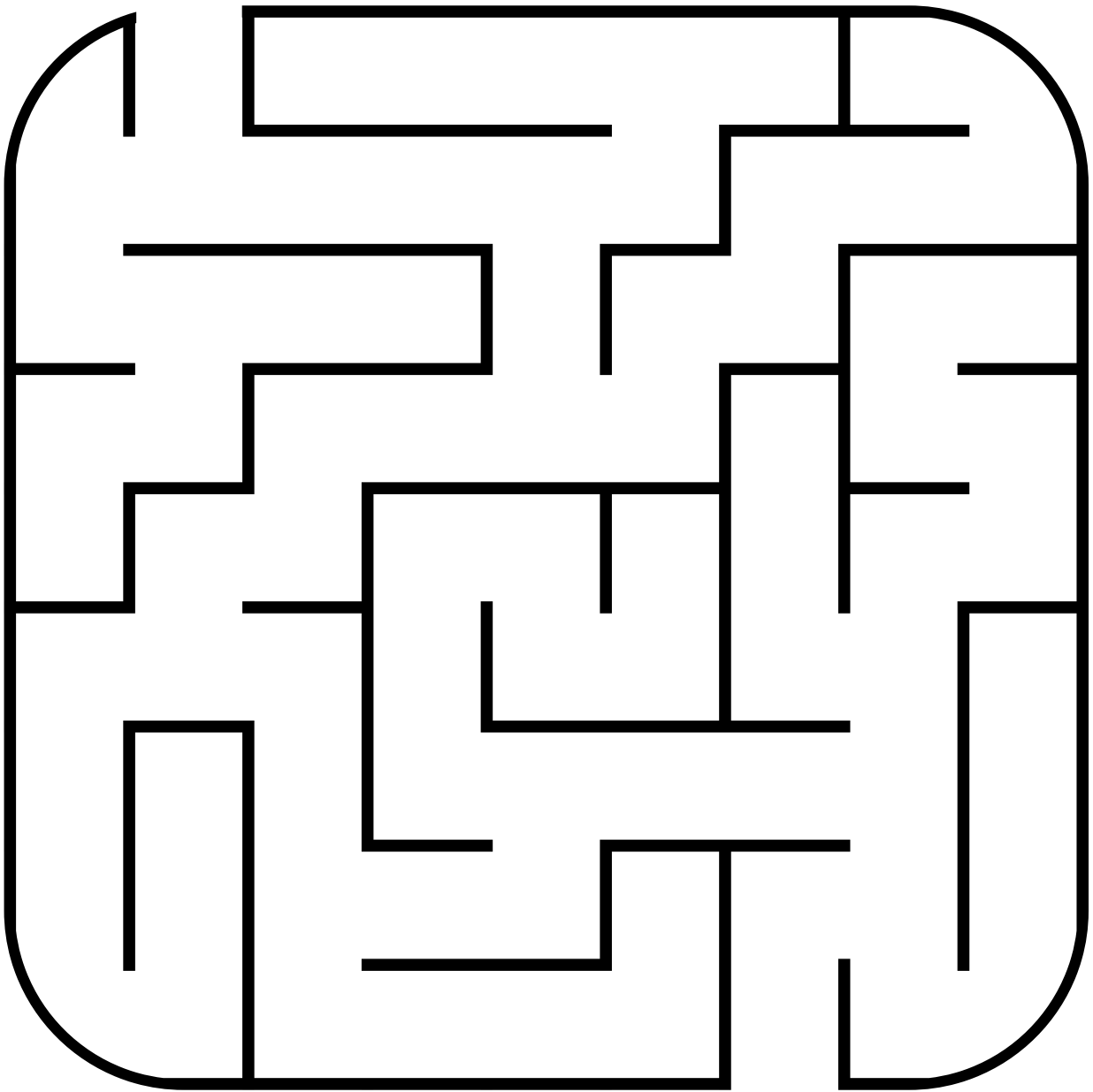


# Finding Jesus in the temple

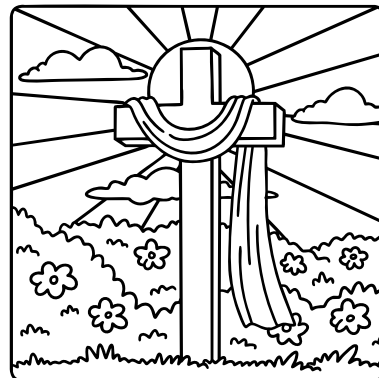
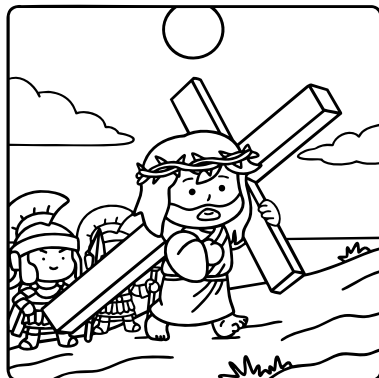
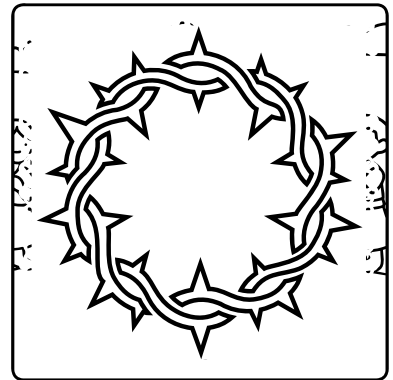
God crowned Mother Mary as Queen of Heaven and Earth.

**who believe in Him.**



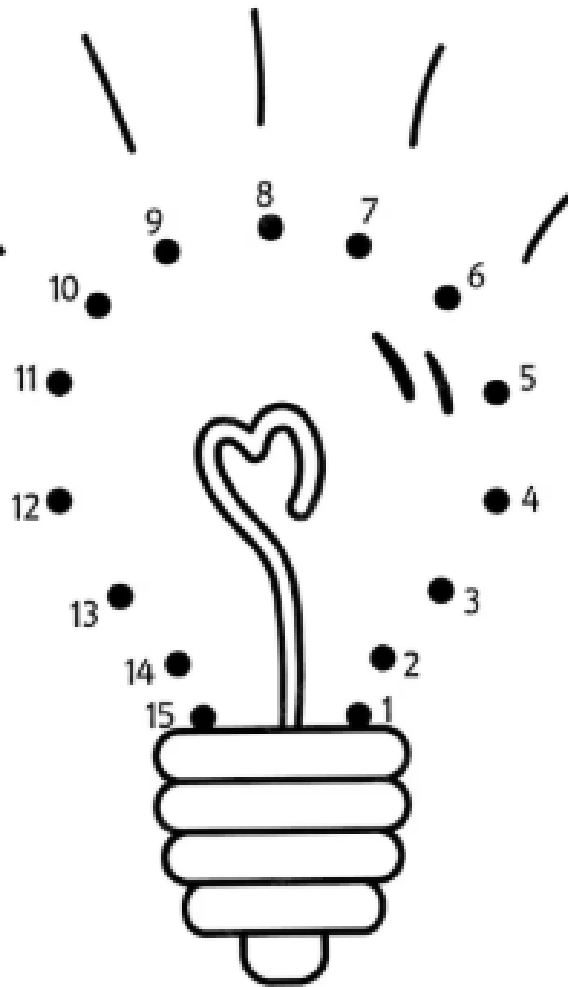
