

(Scriptural) Glorious Mysteries

The Glorious Mysteries explore the aftermath of Jesus' death, presenting Him in the glory of His Divine nature.

In this version of the Rosary, a line from scripture is read on each bead of each decade.

The Resurrection

- 1. After the sabbath, as the first day of the week was dawning, Mary Magdalene came with the other Mary to inspect the tomb. *Hail Mary...*
- 2. The angel came to the stone, rolled it back and sat on it. Hail Mary...
- 3. Then the angel spoke, addressing the women: "Do not be frightened. I know you are looking for Jesus the crucified, but he is not here. He has been raised, exactly as he promised." *Hail Mary...*
- 4. "He has been raised from the dead and now goes ahead of you to Galilee." Hail Mary...
- 5. On the evening of the first day of the week, even though the disciples had locked the doors of the place where they were.... Jesus came and stood before them. "Peace be with you." He said. *Hail Mary...*
- 6. In their panic and fright they thought they were seeing a ghost. Hail Mary...
- 7. He said to them, "Why are you disturbed? Look at my hands and my feet; it is really I." *Hail Mary...*
- 8. At the sight of the Lord, the disciples rejoiced. Hail Mary ...
- 9. "Peace be with you." Jesus said again. "As the Father has sent me, so I send you." *Hail Mary...*
- 10. "I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, though he should die, will come to life." *Hail Mary...*



The Ascension

- 1. Jesus led His disciples out near Bethany, and with hand upraised, blessed them.
- 2. Jesus addressed them in these words: "Full authority has been given to me both in heaven and on earth."
- 3. "Go therefore, and make disciples of all the nations. Baptize them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."
- 4. "And know that I am with you always, until the end of the world."
- 5. "The man who believes in the good news and accepts baptism will be saved; the man who refuses to believe in it will be condemned..."
- 6. As Jesus blessed them, he left them and was taken up to heaven.
- 7. He was lifted up before their eyes in a cloud which took him from their sight.
- 8. "This Jesus who has been taken from you will return, just as you saw him go up to the heavens."
- 9. They fell down to do him reverence, then returned to Jerusalem filled with joy
- 10. Jesus took his seat at God's right hand.

The Descent of the Holy Spirit

- 1. Jesus said, "I will ask the Father and he will give you another Paraclete, to be with you always."
- 2. "The Paraclete, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will instruct you in everything, and remind you of all that I told you."
- 3. "Within a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit."
- 4. "You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes down on you; then you are to be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea....and even to the ends of the earth."
- 5. When the day of Pentecost came it found them gathered in one place. Suddenly from up in the sky there came a noise like a strong driving wind, which was heard all through the house.



- 6. Tongues as of fire appeared, which parted and came to rest on each of them. All were filled with the Holy Spirit.
- 7. They began to express themselves in foreign tongues and make bold proclamation as the Spirit prompted them.
- 8. Staying in Jerusalem at the time were devout men of every nation. These heard the sound, and assembled in a large crowd. They were confused because each heard the disciples speaking in his own language.
- 9. Peter stood up with the Eleven and addressed them, "You must reform and be baptized, each one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ, that your sins may be forgiven; then you will receive the Holy Spirit."
- 10. Those who accepted his message were baptized; some three thousand were added that day.

The Assumption of Mary

- 1. The Lord God said to the serpent: "I will put enmity between you and the woman and between your offspring and hers."
- 2. "He will strike at your head, while you strike at his heel."
- 3. A great sign appeared in the sky, a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars.
- 4. "Father, all those you gave me, I would have in my company where I am."
- 5. Wherefore she is our mother in the order of grace.
- 6. Taken up to heaven, she did not lay aside this salvific duty, but by her intercession continues to bring us the gifts of eternal salvation.
- 7. "For he has looked upon his servant in her lowliness."
- 8. "All ages to come shall call me blessed."
- 9. "Those who love me I also love, and those who seek me find me... For he who finds me finds life, and wins favor from the Lord."
- 10. Come then my love. My lovely one come.
